January Minutes

Principal's Report – Susan Meymann

- Got through January, not used to full weeks
- Conferences went well
- Open House: lots of questions answered; kindergarten registration ahead of last year
- Thank you for the teacher's lunch
- See printout for additional details
- Considering Freshman English and foreign language options for 8th graders
- Ms Walter is leading students working in "family" groups of kids mixed from K-8 to pack lunches for Our Daily Bread, and in April 8th graders who are at least 14 will be going there to volunteer for a day
- The accreditation goal of improving student problem solving is in the planning stages
- Next year's schedule is being reviewed by the Archdiocese
- Future of the school: it will likely be at least 10 years before the school moves, the Southwest levy may have some effect on enrollment, a sub-committee of the School Committee is being considered
- Safety Training: discussing with Harrison police; possibly making a video

Teacher's Lounge

- Doug Mangold and Russell Montgomery spear-heading it now; have the wish list; 8th grade class donating towards the lounge

Treasurer Report: Missy for Maygan

- Mike Newton, Missy and Meghan have talked about trends from the last 3 years and "extra" money has dwindled away

- Discussion regarding deciding on budget requests

Additional Discussions

- Foreign Language Course Options – Melissa Pitzer
 - o Elective courses possibly during Jag-Time
 - o Send another survey to gauge interest? Need feedback from parents
 - o Difficult to find the time in the day + a teacher
 - o Cincinnati Spanish Academy; CO Spanish Immersion – half day in Spanish
 - o Best window for learning language is up to 11 years
 - o Appreciation of culture; largest growing portion of Catholic population is Spanish
- Future School Committee – Melissa Pitzer
 - o 10 year plan
 - o Keep track of enrollment
 - o Approximately 1/3 of students are from Indiana, but we don't receive state dollars for them
 - o Target recruiting
- Power of the Pencil – Melissa Pitzer
 - o PTC had approved funds for 5th-6th grade
 - o Took a year to get the curriculum
 - o Takes 12 sessions
 - o Mrs Smith will sponsor, but Melissa has not had a chance to discuss with her since receiving materials
 - o Might need to hold off until next year
 - o Visitors / potential families have asked about Power of the Pen program
 - o Dianna Bley is being asked to edit
