Kindergarten Parent Information Night takes place next Wednesday, January 27th at 7:00 p.m. in the school cafeteria.

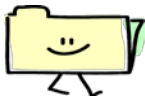
If you have children who will be five by September 30th of this year, please join our kindergarten teachers, school psychologist, nurse at the school, and me to learn more about kindergarten readiness and the full and partial day kindergarten program we provide here at St. Johns. This is an adult-oriented evening and not designed to address the interest of young children. Little ones will have plenty of time to become accustomed to their teacher and classroom through our transition to kindergarten plans. Parents will also need to sign up for a kindergarten screening time to take place in late May. Please be sure to invite parents you know who may be considering sending their child to our school.

With the registration season fast approaching, I wanted to provide a little advance notice regarding some improvements we've made to the enrollment and re-enrollment process (we hope) to make school registration easier for busy families.

Next week, current students will take home only two papers; the first is a cover letter from Father Kemper, explaining the tuition and payment options. The second page has been designed to assist you with the enrollment process. Parents will find all forms (such as registration paperwork, emergency contacts, health history tuition assistance forms, etc.) are available online at www.sjbharrison.org, and will also discover how to register and arrange for tuition payment options online. The registration period does not begin until January 31, 2016. During Open House, the computer lab will be open and Mr. Feist will be available to help parents begin their online registration process. Please remember that new kindergarten and preschool students must provide a copy of their birth certificate to verify they meet the requirements of school attendance. We are looking forward to a wonderful year of learning experiences for both students and staff next year and hope you will continue to be a part of the St. John the Baptist school family.
