Although parents can check student grades at any time through your child's *Option C* account, **paper report cards are scheduled to be sent home with students in grades one through eight on Wednesday, October 25.** Parents should be looking for the prompts to sign up for parent/teacher conferences. Please mark your calendars for conferences on either Wednesday, October 25 between 5 and 8:30 p.m. or Thursday, November 2 between 4 and 6:30 p.m. If you are signing up for conferences for more than one child, please avoid scheduling them directly back-to-back, as you may need some travel time.

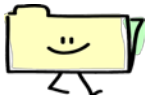
This is a reminder students should not be in the building before 8:20 a.m. as teachers are not expected in their classrooms until that time and there is no safe supervision. If you have a consistent need for your child to be at school, prior to 8:20 a.m. please register your children for the before school YMCA childcare, through the Clippard YMCA. Supervision and a light breakfast begin at 6:30 a.m. and may be just what you need to make your morning schedule a little smoother. Children must be registered before starting the YMCA Latchkey program, but are then signed in the cafeteria and safely supervised until being dismissed to classrooms at 8:20 a.m. It is fire safety week. Next week, our youngest students will enjoy a visit from the Harrison Fire Department. This is the perfect time of year to replace batteries in your smoke detectors and to practice a family fire drill before colder weather sets in for the winter. Have a safe and blessed long weekend. **Since the Southwest buses are running just for us on Tuesday, please check the earlier emails for transportation changes and expect your sons and daughters to arrive home a bit earlier than usual since everyone will leave at 3:30 p.m.**

Available for Grades 3-8

Season Dates:

- Sign-Ups - October 2 - 31
- Evaluations (grades 5-8) - Sat 11/4 from 5:00 – 6:00. Possible make-up date Sunday 11/5 from 7:30 – 8:30
- Practices Start - mid-December (depends on gym availability); generally 2 weeks prior to games. Practices are typically 2x/week with one game/weekend.
- Games - Approximately 8 games with the addition of possible tournaments
- Season - mid/late January to mid-March
- Fees: \$80

Basketball Program

Instructional - Grades 3 & 4

- Focus is introducing & developing skills
- Girls should learn to play ALL positions
