A MESSAGE FROM MRS. MEYMANN

As cold and flu season quickly approach, it is time to remind families about our policies for student illness. Getting plenty of rest and exercise, eating a healthy and well-balanced diet, and having students sneeze and cough into the crook of their arm and wash hands frequently are all habits to be encouraged. When your child becomes ill, please respect everyone's health by following these simple rules:

- Children should be kept home from school until they have been fever free (**WITHOUT** fever medication to mask symptoms) for at least 24 hours.
- If your child has vomited or had diarrhea within the last 24 hours, they should remain at home.
- When children return from an illness, they should bring a note stating the reason for the absence. There are certain medical conditions, such as Whooping Cough or Head Lice, warranting we notify other parents of possible contagious outbreaks.

These policies are enforced in order to minimize the spread of illness among students and staff. Thank you for helping everyone stay healthy!

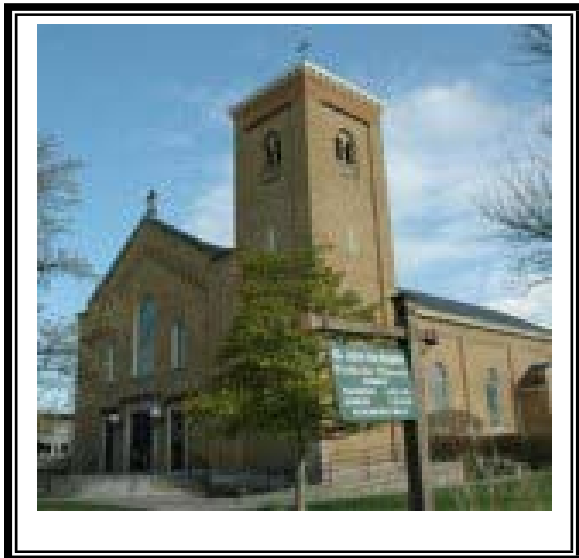
Keep up the Fantastic Work!!

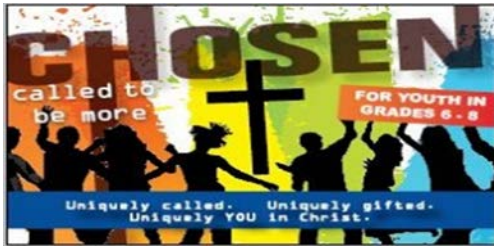
