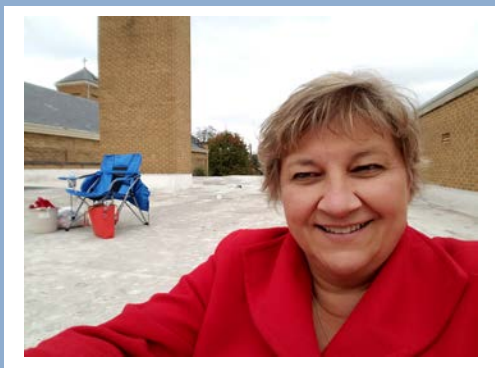
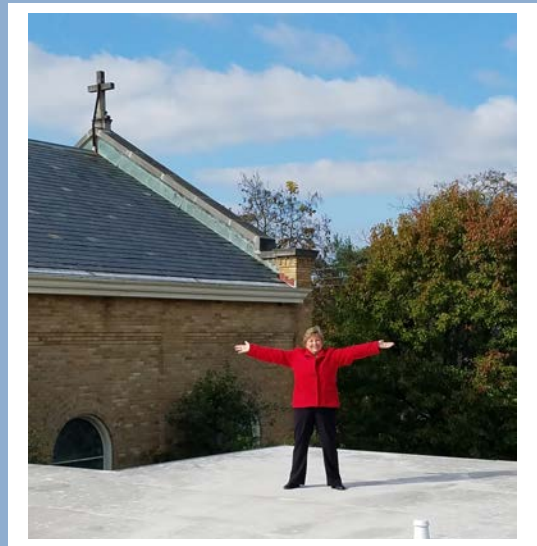
The JagWear Spirit Shop will be open this Sunday from 12:00 - 5:30, during the Turkey Dinner/Craft Show
