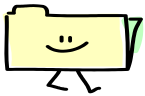

The students of St. John the Baptist School and St. John the Baptist PSR are teaming up to help the local pantries with their toilet paper supplies. We hope you can help.

Why do we need to collect toilet paper, anyway? A lot of people assume that food stamps can be used for just about everything in the grocery store, but that's not so; they're strictly limited to food. So, a family who is just getting by with help from government programs, may have trouble coming up with the money to purchase things like toilet paper and soap.

If the school collects more than 4,073 rolls of toilet paper, the whole school gets donuts.

Donations of toiletries will also be accepted but will not be included in the donut count.
